

EATON & ISRAEL

- Between 2008 & 2021, 'Eaton Mission Systems –Wimborne' (known previously as 'Cobham Mission Systems' and 'Flight Refuelling' prior to that) applied for a total of 72 export licenses to sell military equipment to Israel. All 72 were approved.
- Eaton opened two sites in Israel in 2018: a sales, marketing and support centre in Ra'anana and a logistics and distribution centre in Ashdod.
- Eaton supplies parts for the following aircraft used by the Israeli military:

Sikorsky UH-60 'Black Hawk' helicopter (Israeli name : Yanshuf) – medium lift helicopter

- Eaton supplies 21 different parts including hydraulic & fuel system assemblies
- Israel has 48 of these aircraft
- The UH-60 is being used to transport Israeli troops in Gaza

Lockheed Martin C-130 (Israeli name : Shimshon) – transport aircraft

- Eaton supplies a total of 38 parts, including fuel & hydraulic systems.
- Israel has a total of 11 of these aircraft
- The C-130 is being used to re-supply Israeli ground troops in Gaza

Sikorsky CH53-K (Israeli name : Yas'ur) – heavy lift helicopter

- Eaton supplies fuel, hydraulic & cockpit control panels
- A deal was made in August 2023 (between US Marine Corps and Israel) to supply a total of 35 of these aircraft to Israel, worth \$2.7bn

EATON & UK

Eaton supplies parts for the following aircraft used by the UK military

Eurofighter Typhoon FGR4 – strike fighter

- Eaton supplies 37 different parts including hydraulics, fuel systems, sensor & control systems, and the motor which supplies ammunition to the gun
- The bombing operation conducted by UK Typhoon aircraft on Yemen was conducted from their base in Cyprus, a round trip of over 5,000km which necessitated in-flight refuelling. The in-flight re-fuelling equipment used on the Typhoon was supplied by Eaton.

Boeing C-17 – transport aircraft

- Eaton supplies 41 different parts including hydraulics and fuel systems
- Between 10 October & 10 November, the UK military made 33 military transport flights to Israel.

USA

Eaton supplies parts for the following aircraft used by the US military

Boeing F/A-18E/F Super Hornet and EA-18G Growler – strike fighter

- Eaton supplies 40 different parts including hydraulics, fuel systems, sensor & control systems, and the motor which supplies ammunition to the gun
- This aircraft is being used by the USA to bomb Yemen

EATON MISSION SYSTEMS, THE US & UK

Eaton Mission Systems manufactures hydraulic and fuel systems for the Typhoon Eurofighter and the Boeing F/A-18E/F Super Hornet.

- These aircraft were recently used by the US and the UK to bomb Yemen, and without a vote in the UK Parliament.*
- Countries that have signed the Genocide Convention have a duty to take action to try to prevent genocide taking place. The UK and the US bombed Yemen to prevent it from helping to stop the genocide in Gaza.*

Yemen said it would stop blocking the Red Sea if Israel stopped it's genocidal bombing of Gaza. Instead of a ceasefire though the US and UK chose escalation.

Eaton Mission Systems manufactures hydraulic and fuel systems for the Boeing C-17 transport aircraft.

- In a 30 days period from the 10th October 2023, the UK sent 33 C-17 military transport flights to help Israel.*



EATON MISSION SYSTEMS & ISRAEL

Eaton Mission Systems manufactures hydraulic and fuel systems for the Lockheed Martin C130 and Sikorsky UH-60 Black Hawk helicopter.

- These have been used to transport and re-supply Israeli troops in Gaza, where thousands of civilians have been driven from their homes and killed.

- In August 2023 the US agreed to sell 35 UH-60 Black Hawk helicopters to Israel, in a deal worth \$2.7bn.

- Eaton Mission Systems has at least two sites in Israel facilitating trade with the war machine. The Israeli army has been brutally oppressing the Palestinian people for over 75 years.

- On 21/1/2024 the death toll in Gaza stood at 25,000. 62,000 people have been injured and 8,000 are missing.
